Terms & Conditions

Practical Experience

- Students must have minimum 2yrs regular yoga practice before embarking on this teacher training course. If you are not a current student of Turiya Yoga, a reference from your main teacher will be required to confirm you have been practicing consistently. There may be exceptions to this requirement, however this is at the tutor's discretion.
- Entry to the course is dependent on a pre-course assessment, which includes a 121 chat with the tutor (in person or by telephone/Zoom), and if you are not a current student, you will need to attend at least one of the tutor's classes to ensure that you are at the level required to attend the course.

Booking

- Once your pre-course assessment and interview has taken place, deposit of £250 is required to secure your place.
- Bookings received by August 31st 2026, will receive a £250 discount on the course cost.
- Payments can either be made monthly or quarterly, with full and final payment for the course due 12 weeks before the start date, (by 6th March 2026)
- There will be a maximum of 12 students on each course.
- The tutor reserves the right to refuse a place to students who have not paid their deposit or fees by the required dates.

Course Dates

The 2027/28 course starts in May 2027, and runs for 12 months. Dates are:

- 6 x in person training weekends at the studio at Treflach Farm, nr Oswestry, Shropshire (SY10 9HX). These run 9am-5pm on both the Saturday and Sunday on the following dates:
 - 29/30 May 2027
 - 24/25 July 2027
 - 25/26 September 2027
 - 27/28 November 2027
 - 22/23 January 2028
 - 25/26 March 2028

- 1 x 4 day/3night Final Assessment retreat, held at a retreat centre in North Wales (Cae Nant, nr Llanfyllin. SY22 5JE) 26-29 May 2028.
- 36 weekly Zoom calls, running on Wednesday evenings during term-time 6-8pm.

Fees

Included:

- Training and assessment by a qualified Yoga Alliance Professionals Senior Yoga Teacher.
- Handouts will be emailed to participants before each session. These will build into your full training manual over the duration of the course.
- 6 x in person training weekends.
- 1 x 4 day/3night Final Assessment retreat.
- 36 weekly Zoom calls, running on Wednesday evenings during term-time 6-8pm.

Not included:

- Travel, accommodation and food are not included (apart from your final retreat accommodation, which *is* included in the price).
- Books: A recommended reading list will be provided on booking.

Commitment

- You are expected to attend 100% of the in person and live Zoom sessions. However, if you are unable to attend for any reason, inform your tutor directly with as much notice as possible. You must achieve a minimum attendance of 80% in order to pass the course.
- All assignments must be completed by their due date, in good time for the final assessment retreat. Any outstanding assignments at the retreat, mean that you cannot pass the course.
- You are expected to commit to a daily personal yoga practice throughout the course.

Refund Policy

- Prior to the deadline for full payment, if you choose to cancel the course, contact your tutor directly, explaining in detail the reasons for your cancellation. Any payments, less your initial deposit, will be refunded in full.
- Once the deadline for full payment has passed, if you decide to leave the course, contact your tutor directly, explaining in detail the reasons for your cancellation. No refund will be payable.

Cancellation of Course

- If delays, changes or cancellation is required by the tutor, due to circumstances outside of their control (for example, but not limited to, industrial action by third parties, civil commotion, riot, invasion, terrorist attack or threat of terrorist attack, war (whether declared or not) or threat or preparation for war, fire, explosion, earthquake, adverse weather conditions, subsidence, epidemic, natural disaster, or failure of public or private telecommunications networks), we will contact you as soon as reasonably possible. Our obligations under these terms will be suspended and the course will continue as soon as possible.

Complaint Procedure

- In the unlikely event that there is any problem with the course:
 - (a) please contact the tutor as soon as reasonably possible; and
 - (b) please give the tutor reasonable opportunity to address the problem.
- If you are a consumer (and not a business), you have legal rights in relation to the course if it is not carried out with reasonable skill and care. GDPR Policy

- Your contact data will be held for the duration of the course and will only be used by Turiya Yoga for the purposes of the course.
